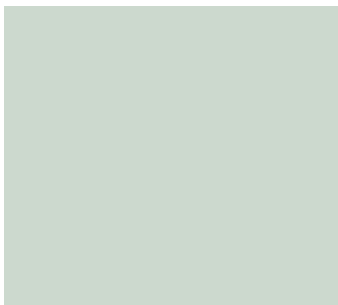

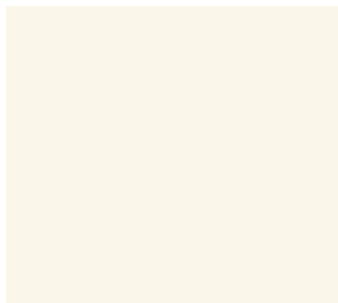


CAMPUS LIFE

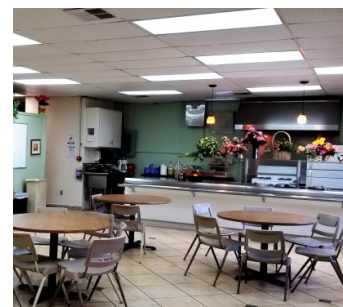
Students seeking to be part of a close-knit community reside in on-campus housing at the Patten University location. Various living accommodations are available, including twin sharing and triple sharing apartments.
